

Which supply chain actions did you take in response to COVID19?




SC leaders respond with short-term actions, with negative long-term impact





Did your supply chain get disrupted by COVID – 19?




Supply Chains are disrupted by variability or shocks in demand or supply





How prepared were you for disruptions happening along your supply chain?




Companies feel not better prepared for the next major disruption





What are your focus areas to strengthen your supply chain against future disruptions?






Customer ships supply from mines to warehouse

Planning horizon > 5 months




